



Eifel German Single Malt Whisky

Released in 2018, only 1200 bottles of the original US bottling of Eifel German Single Malt Whisky were produced. This whisky was distilled from 100% unpeated malted barley. Distillation was done in the German tradition: a primary distillation in a column still (including the grist), followed by a second distillation in a small copper pot still. The alcohol content was reduced to 60% before entering casks. The spirit then rested for at least 4 and a half years in freshly emptied and refill red wine casks from France and Germany. These casks are primarily American oak. The French wine casks previously held Bordeaux wines, while the German casks previously held German Pinot Noir, and were emptied only a few hours before the spirit enters the casks. Following this initial ageing, the whisky was then finished for at least a year in freshly emptied Sherry casks. Eifel German Single Malt Whisky earned a 91 Point rating from Jim Murray's Whisky Bible.
