



Golden Moon Ex Gratia – A Genepi

Based upon a description Based of a spirit listed in an executioner's notebook from the 1580s, ExGratia is a style of liqueur known as Genepi.

Genepi are made from herbs including wormwoods that grow in the alpine regions of Europe. What makes ExGratia different from other Genepi is that it contains several exotic herbs and spices including "black spice" an Asian herb that was highly prized during the middle-ages in Europe and the Middle East.

This type of elixir was used by apothecaries for a variety of purposes and was typically given by executioners to the condemned as a last act of kindness to all but those guilty of the most heinous of crimes.
