



INVERROCHE, (in-ver-rosh)...

is a **craft distillery**, established in 2007 by Lorna Scott, situated close to the most southern tip of Africa (Cape Agulhas) in the small seaside town of **Stillbaai**. A quaint town where the Atlantic and Indian oceans meet. INVERROCHE is aptly named ... "**the confluence of rocks**"

- These Gins are all made with several **locally sourced botanicals**, some of which are unique to South Africa. Vegetation in the Cape (the smallest yet most diverse floral Kingdom in the world) is called **Fynbos** ... literally, "fine bush".
- The Gin's are made from a **Sugar Cane base** at 96 proof and then diluted with local filtered mountain water to 57% before being distilled in a **wood fired pot still**, with a capacity of 900 L.
- The customized Gin basket is **untraditionally** placed lower in the potstill (not in the neck) which allows for some condensation of vapors to re-infuse longer with the botanicals.
- To enhance the more delicate fynbos aromas and capture their natural color & aromatic top notes, a post distillation steep occurs before further dilution. The color is completely natural. It is not stabilized and due to seasonal changes it also can vary slightly in hue: a sign of authenticity and uniqueness - **every batch truly is a limited edition**.
- The head and tail are discarded and only the heart is kept. 900L yield approximately 600L of distilled Gin at 43% Alc. by Vol.
- **Everything** is bottled **by hand** through a 3 nozzle dispenser (1500 bottles per day)
