
Jean Cavé

Armagnac, France



Henry Cavé is the fourth generation of the family to run this distillery since it opened in 1883. With Henry at the helm, the distillery benefits from generations of knowledge, as well as a shared sense of tradition and purpose. This has allowed them to retain continuity and an enduring sense of place. Today, with more than one hundred thirty vintages of their Armagnac produced, they have built up a stock of old bottles that few other houses can match and can offer a wide range of bottlings that will delight newcomers to this spirit, as well as delight serious collectors and afficionados.

Hors d'Age (XO) Armagnac

Deep amber color with golden highlights. The nose is marked mainly by orange peel, woody vanilla and smoky notes. The palate is lively and complex. with spice and notes of anise; it has a long finish, with notes of wood and cooked prune.

Trois Étoiles Armagnac

Golden color. The nose is dominated by fruit, with notes of flowers; subtle and aromatic, with lovely fruit and length of the palate and a hint of spice on the finish.

VSOP Armagnac

Mahogany color with copper highlights. Fresh fruits, candied citrus, spice and vanilla on the nose; flavors of prunes, plums, and orange peel linger on the finish.
