

LANTIDES ESTATE CUVÉE



Origin – Type:

Protected Geographical Indication of Peloponnese – Dry Red Wine.

Varieties:

Cabernet Sauvignon 30%, Merlot 30%, Agiorgitiko (St. George) 40%.

Annual Production and Vineyard Yield:

6,648 bottles/year – 6000 kg/ha – Asprokampos Nemea Vineyard, Altitude 650 m. Lime-clayey soil with 30° incline.

Vinification & Characteristics:

Red wine vinification method including diffusion and storage in oak barrels for 24 months up to bottling, followed by storage in wine cellars for a further 12 months. Strong tannins, great body, and a good balance between acidity and alcohol promise one of the best wines produced by Lantides. Store in a cool place and decant into a carafe. Can age for 8-10 years without cork changes.
