Made from a recipe passed down by Léonce Récapet, great-grandfather of François Lurton, an inventive distiller, this extra-dry white vermouth is made made from selected Sauvignon Blanc grapes grown in the Gers region and distilled to 70° before being enriched with other ingredients which, once macerated (tinctures), enhance the natural qualities of this variety. The result is then blended with a base wine from the most recent vintage produced at Domaine Les Fumées Blanches from 100% Sauvignon Blanc grapes.

Léonce Extra Dry Vermouth

This blend of wine, wine spirit, and tinctures results in a well-balanced vermouth with an intense and complex aromatic profile.
