

Mourne Dew Irish Whiskey

Based on a 19th century recipe passed down from the distiller's great grandfather. This recipe was made in illicit stills in mountainy ref-uges, hidden in the Mourne Mountains. The still was finally uncovered by the excise men in 1878 and the recipe has lain dormant. Until now! It has been updated in terms of the casking policy, with a greater selection of oaks available than was the case 200 years ago! It is excellent both in a straight serve with ice/water or as a cocktail whiskey. Mourne Dew's Irish Whiskey earned a Silver Medal at the London Spirits Competition.



COUNTRY OF ORIGIN: Ireland

TYPE OF SPIRIT: Blended Irish Whiskey

MASH BILL: Grain (Maize) 90%, Malted barley 10%



CASK: Triple distilled malt 30% in virgin oak, Triple distilled grain 60% in American bourbon oak, TDM 7% in rye oak, Peated TDM 3% bourbon oak

PROOF: 80

TASTING NOTE:

Nose: Clean with no 'off' notes. Soft, mellow with vanilla/toffee, berries and a hint of peat. Taste: Very pleasant and like the nose, vanilla/toffee/berries with the peated malt just showing through. Aftertaste: Pleasant and soft on the palate.
